- ✓ For any students who will be entering grades 5th through 8th in the Fall of 2018
- ✓ Sign-up your student athlete for us to acquire player name and contact information
- ✓ Registration paperwork, Physicals, Parent/Athlete agreement, Apparel order and PAYMENT due at the Mandatory parent/athlete meeting on Sunday, July 15th, 2018 at the New Holstein High School
 - 6pm – 7pm: All paperwork will be handed in at this meeting.
 - 7-7:30pm: Parent/Athlete meeting.

First Part: SIGN UP!

1. **DEADLINE FOR SIGN UP IS FRIDAY, JULY 13TH, 2018**
2. Go to our web site at www.huskyyouthfb.org
3. From the HOME page, click on the RED button to sign-up for tackle football
4. Fill in the information on the screen and press submit
5. YOU NOW HAVE YOUR STUDENT ATHLETE SIGNED UP!
6. We will send you pertinent information prior to the parent/athlete meeting in July.

Second Part: FORMS for Participation in Husky Youth Tackle Football

1. Go to our web site at www.huskyyouthfb.org to download forms
2. Click on the “FORMS AND INFORMATION” link
3. Forms – download and print the following forms. Fill them out and bring to the parent/athlete meeting in July
 - a. Registration/Concussion History/Medical Release/Parent/Athlete Agreement form
 - i. Download, print and review all concussion information
 - b. Physical form
 - i. Schedule a physical with your physician and have them provide paperwork showing the approved physical
 - ii. All students in grades 5th through 8th will be required to have a physical completed by a physician.
 - iii. A physical is good for two years. If completed last year, you will be good for this year.
 - c. Apparel
 - i. Select any of the apparel we offer. Order form and payment is due at the July meeting.

Third Part: FEES & VOLUNTEERING!

1. Fees due at the parents meeting:
 - a. 6th through 8th grade = \$100 per student
 - b. 5th grade = \$60 per student
2. Volunteering:
 - a. We will need parent signup for concessions, admission and grilling.
 - b. If you don't sign up at the registration, we will randomly select names to fill in spots.

NOTE: IMPACT Testing:

- a. All 7th and 8th grade athlete's must have a certified IMPACT concussion test completed prior to the start of the season.
- b. The test is conducted by the school at no cost to you.
- c. The IMPACT test is good for two years. If you had it last year, you are good for this year. If you're new and didn't have one last year, you will need this.

 - 7pm: MANDATORY PARENT'S MEETING AT THE NH HIGH SCHOOL Cafeteria
- Wednesday, August 1st : First practice and equipment handout at Funke Field (behind NHES)
 - 5pm: ALL PLAYERS MUST REPORT TO FUNKE FIELD FIRST. DO NOT SHOW UP AT THE PAVILION!
 - Players will be dismissed by grade from Funke Field to the Civic Pavilion for equipment. 8th first and ending with 5th grade
- 1st three practices will be helmets only. Full pads on the 4th practice. Bring LOTS OF WATER
