Dear Parents,

It's hard to believe but December is already here. This month brings us some special liturgies, Advent prayer services, reconciliation service, and the annual Christmas program.

Next week's liturgy is on Friday at Holy Rosary for the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. Students in grades 5K-8 will attend. Students should wear the black school polos along with dress pants/skirt.

Students in grades 3-8 will participate in the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Friday, December 15. Fr. Pat from St. Nazianz will hear the confessions.

The Christmas program is at 6:00 on December 19. The concert begins with the bands and is followed by 3K, 4K-5K, and the musical story of Christmas by grades 1-8. At the conclusion of the musical, students in 4K and 5K will rejoin the older students for a closing song.
