PRINCIPAL'S LETTER

Dear Parents,

Thank you to all who returned the Catholic Schools Week form this past week. Please remember that next week FRIDAY is the deadline for accepting meal reservations. If your child will be eating or having a drink, he/she will also need to pay \$2.50. This fee cannot be deducted from the hot lunch account.

Catholic Schools Week is rapidly approaching and with that comes registration for next school year. The Board of Trustees has opted to keep the tuition rate the same for next year as it was this year, if registration materials are turned by April 1. After that date, an additional \$100 will be added onto the tuition fee. Registration materials will be sent home with your oldest child on January 24.

I also wish to remind families with children entering 4K, 5K, and grade 1 that the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) is available to qualifying families. If your adjusted gross income on your 2018 federal income tax return falls within the following limits, you will qualify for free tuition. The registration period for WPCP is February 1 through April 20. Please contact me for further instructions if you qualify. Those families already in the program will need to register on-line as done previously.

For each additional family member add \$9,504.

Divine Savior School is also part of the state's Special Needs Scholarship Program (SNSP). Any student in any grade from 4K-8 that has an Individual Education Plan from the public school qualifies for this program. There is no tuition charge for these students. They are eligible to receive speech and language services, occupational therapy, and tutoring services. There are no parental income limitations for this program. Registrations for the SNSP may be made at any time during the school year.

If you qualify for either of these programs, please contact me for more information. Or, if you know of a family in either situation who might be interested in a Catholic school education, please let them know about these programs.
