Dear Parents,

I hope you had a wonderful Christmas celebration. January is a busy month, beginning with the 8th grade retreat next week. The second quarter ends on January 16. Parent/teacher conferences are scheduled for January 24 and you should have received a Sign-Up Genius invitation this week to schedule a conference.

Catholic Schools Week begins on Sunday, January 27. We began rotating the parish site to kick-off the week. This year, we would like you and your children to attend the 7:45 Mass at St. Ann. It's early, but we are hoping you will be able to have your child attend and participate. A sign-up form is included with this newsletter. Please send it back on Monday so that we know what to expect.

On Monday, January 28, we will celebrate Special Persons Day. Please invite grandparents or other special guests to celebrate with your child. The day will begin with liturgy at 8:00 (which replaces the Tuesday Mass), followed by a light breakfast, and tour of the Book Fair and school. The special event will end with classes resuming at 10:40. Please complete the luncheon section on the response form and return it next week. When the form and payment is received, your child will be issued tickets for the meal. **THE DEADLINE FOR THE MEAL SIGN-UP IS FRIDAY, JANUARY 18.** We need to order the food by then. The meal will include an egg/ham/cheese sandwich, mandarin oranges, cocoa or coffee. The cost for students and adults is \$2.50. This cannot be deducted from the children's hot lunch account.
