Mrs. Bonde will remain as our cook on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Ann Klapperich, who retired last year, will help out one day a week as needed. If you know of anyone interested in a part-time, 3x/week, part-time cooking position, please have him/her contact the school office.

I am pleased to report that we have a new office/business manager starting on March 19. Her name is Amy Schweitzer and we are very excited to have her join our school community. Thank you for your patience as we make this personnel change in the office. I believe we have the tuition and hot lunch records all updated now. If you notice any errors, please let us know.

I also want to clarify the busing routines for school delays and cancellations. In the event that either New Holstein or Kiel CLOSES, Divine Savior will also close. If one delays, but not the other, you need to follow the busing plans of your resident district. So, this past Tuesday, the Kiel buses ran 2 hours later than normal because of the 2-hour delay. Since New Holstein schools opened as normal, all New Holstein district students had to board the bus at the normal time and the shuttle bus would have brought them to Divine Savior as usual. The district(s) will not run another bus route if it is open at normal hours. Likewise if New Holstein delays and Kiel remains open, all Kiel district students would need to board the bus at the usual times. In the event that happens, the teachers will be at school as usual.
