Dear Parents,

I hope you enjoyed the concert this week. Thank you to Mrs. Hartman, Sister Elizabeth, and Mr. Pierce for their work in putting the program together and to the students for all their hard work and practice. If you wish to see and hear the performance again, the third and fourth graders will be playing their recorder piece at Mass next Tuesday and students in 4K and 5K will sing Joy, Joy, Joy and This Little Light of Mine.

I hope you have had a chance to review your child's MAP test results which were sent home last week. I would like to point out our school's achievement. In science, 100% of our students' subtest scores were average to high. In language, the percent was 98%. In reading, the percent was 96% and in math the percent was 92%.

As part of the safe schools' initiative, schools are to have one entry and exit point. Other than busing students, the breezeway entrance has been our main entry point. Beginning Monday, the bus students will also be entering and exiting via the breezeway instead of the gym door entrance.
