A NOTE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents,

As you know, the school hosted an Accreditation Site Visit Team in October. We received the report last week. The team's task was to validate the school's level of compliance on 73 benchmarks. The school met the goal expectation on 6 of the benchmarks and exceeded the goal expectation on the other 67. No benchmarks were cited for partially meeting or failure to meet.

The team commended the school staff on the degree to which the Catholic faith is radiated in the classroom, to the students, and throughout the entire school. They noted that it was obvious the mission statement drove all that occurs in the school.

The team was impressed with the use of achievement data and other classroom assessments to develop individual learning goals and instruction. The school was also commended for its personalized education model that engages the students in rigorous learning opportunities that follow national and diocesan standards. The team noted that the faculty and staff are extremely dedicated in their time commitment and collaboration to provide the best educational experiences for the students.

They noted that the school has practices in place for students to self-monitor, assess for effort and attitude, and reflect on how they demonstrate their faith.

The Board of Trustees was also commended for their deep commitment to the operational vitality of the school.

The next phase involves the staff's development of goals to move all benchmarks to the "exceeds expectation" level. These plans will be submitted at the end of Spring and the accreditation board will meet to grant the accreditation next summer. The school staff appreciates the support of the parents and parishioners in the mission of the school. The accreditation process has validated everyone's dedication and efforts.

Our mission and Catholic identity will be on display again at next Tuesday's liturgy. We encourage the students to share their blessings with the less fortunate by bringing in some food items to be shared with the food pantry. Please have your child bring in an item(s) to be given to the St. Vincent DePaul Society.

Our next newsletter will be December 1. On behalf of the faculty and staff, I would like to extend to you our wishes for a wonderful Thanksgiving celebration. Remember to pray for our children and thank God for the blessing they are in our lives.

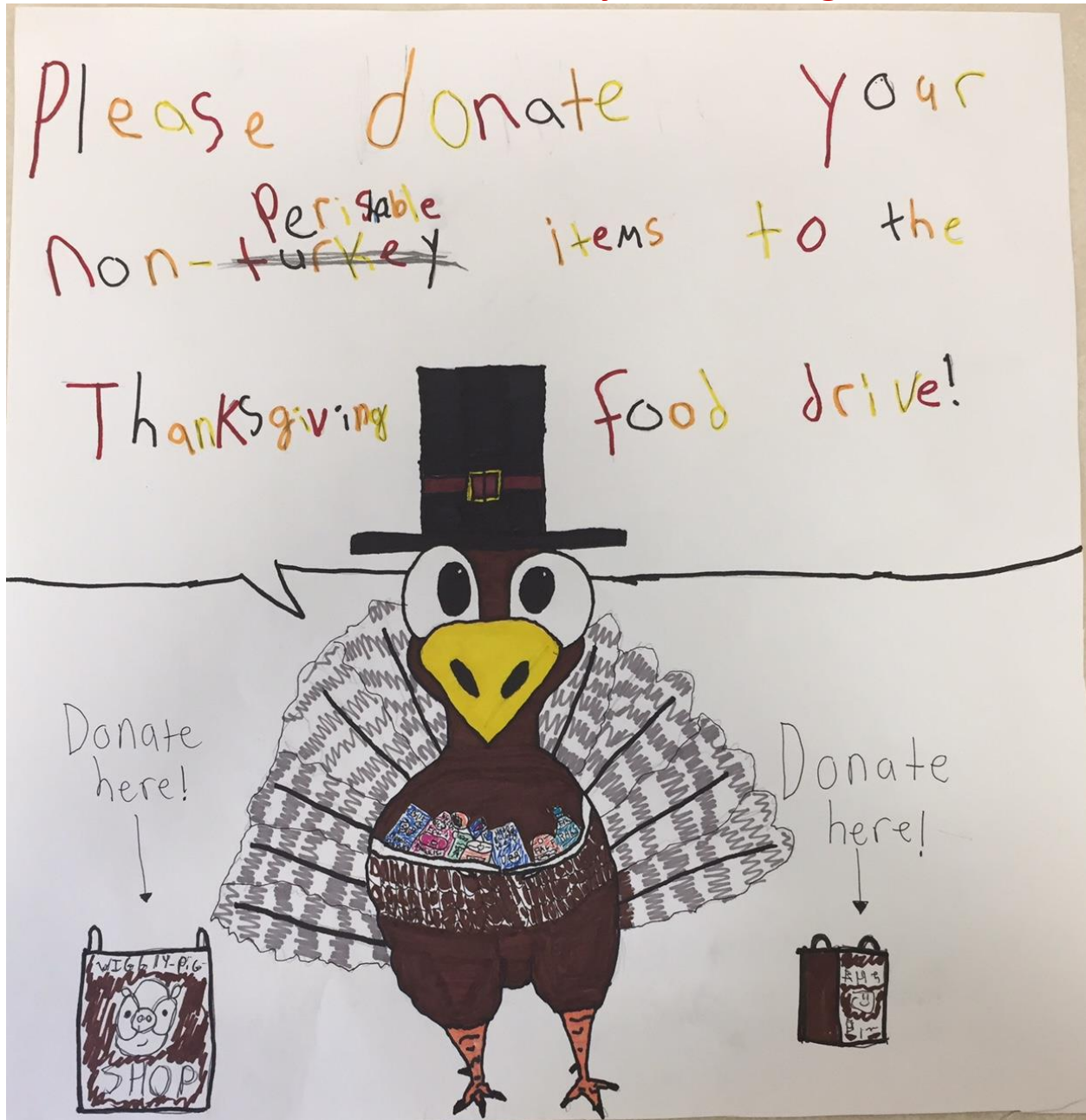
