A NOTE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents,

The site visit for our accreditation has been completed. The staff met with the team at the conclusion of their visit yesterday, at which they indicated we would be recommended for accreditation. They were very impressed with the school: environment, curriculum, students, staff, parent and board involvement, organization, and operations. Thank you to those who helped with this process and to those who took time when contacted for interviews. After I receive the final report, I will share the details with you.

This upcoming week, those students who were not here for Orientation Day will have their photos taken. Parents who wish to be present for those photos (to pick the best photo) may do so. They are scheduled for 9:00.

On Wednesday, the Lions Club will be at school to do annual vision testing. If they find anything unusual, parents will be notified.

On Thursday, former Green Bay Packer Mike McCoy will speak to students in grades 1-8. He will speak about his Catholic faith and the importance of good decision-making. He focuses on three main points: 1. God has given us unique talents and abilities. 2. We are wonderfully made with a plan and purpose for our lives. 3. We have a free will that God has given us.

On Thursday (October 19) school will be dismissed at 1:15 to accommodate public school busing. Unlike the public school, WE ARE in session on Friday. However, please note that school is **not** in session on October 23 and 24.
