All DAYCARE payments should be put in the locked box in the daycare.

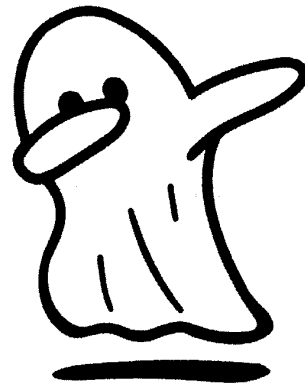
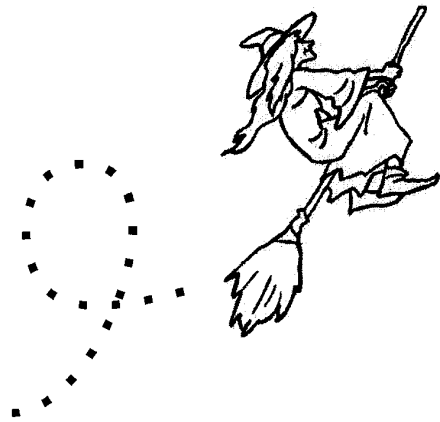
