A NOTE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents,

As we end our week of dress-up days with Halloween today, I would like to remind you that next week, we will NOT have Mass on Tuesday. Rather, students should dress up wearing the school polo shirts for Mass at Holy Rosary on Wednesday. If you wish to join us there, the liturgy begins at 10:00. The 7th and 8th grade students will do the readings, prayers of the faithful, and serve. The sixth graders are cantors. The students in grades 3-5 will serve as the choir. Students in 5K-Grade 2 will participate in a special entrance song. This will be our first liturgy with the 4K in attendance. I would like to remind these parents that all students should wear dress pants or skirt to the liturgy. We believe that everyone has a black school polo. If your child does not have one, please call the school office on Monday.

The time before Mass and the time following lunch will be spent in a SAINTS DAY RETREAT for students in grades 1-8. With help and planning from the 8th graders, the students will learn about the lives of 8 saints and work to identify symbols of those saints. We will conclude the day with praying the litany of the saints.

On November 2 we will remember those who have died as we participate in ALL SOULS' DAY. We have a Book of Remembrance located outside the office. If a loved one has died, and you wish to have your child add a page to that booklet, encourage him/her to get a page, complete it, and add it to the book.

Next Friday, November 3, Spiritus will be visiting Divine Savior School. Spiritus are young adults who serve as missionaries to young Catholics. These charismatic team members who come from all over the diocese and the country travel to area schools sharing their story of being a missionary. They will speak to students in K-1, 2-5, and 6-8. Spiritus is a ministry of Mount Tabor Center in Menasha. More information can be obtained on their website: www.spiritusministries.org.
